

Public Safety Training: Hazardous Materials FRO Decontamination

Saturday, August 28 in Weaverville



COURSE DESCRIPTION:

This hands-on 8-hour course focuses on the “warm zone” activities at a hazardous materials incident. Participants will be certified to wear Level B chemical protective clothing and function as a member of the decontamination team or to function as a Decontamination Leader for this operation. This course will prepare non-Technician responders to setup a decontamination corridor and work within the contamination reduction zone in support of the Technician/Specialist response.

Content will include: types of decon, methods of decon, personal protective clothing, medical considerations, rescue contingencies, decon layout and equipment, and a functional exercise.

- * Participants attending class need to provide an SCBA for the field exercises.
- * Current FRO (First Responder Operational) training is a prerequisite for this course
